RCES Classroom Guidance

Classroom Guidance

Low Community Restrictions:

- Social distancing of 6 ft. as often as possible
- USD 105 will recommend and encourage students and staff to wear a mask.
- All people are required to wash or sanitize their hands when they enter their classroom, during transitions per teacher transgression and before and after eating meals.
- Allow students to use hand sanitizer frequently
- If something must be shared, it needs to be wiped with cleaning wipes between each use and students should wash hands with soap and water
- Use outdoor space when feasible
- Remove supplies or furniture that is not easily cleaned (ie. anything fabric, stuffed animals, extra books, other typically shared supplies)
- Remove extra furniture to allow for more space as possible

Moderate Community Restrictions: **Low community restrictions guidelines PLUS:**

- Shift to Hybrid learning
- Groups of 10 or less when possible
- No sharing of supplies
- Follow additional guidance from county health department

High Community Restrictions:

- Shift to remote learning
- Follow additional guidance from county health department

Suggested Materials:

Sneeze guards, water coolers for each classroom, cleaning supplies, totes for classroom libraries

Transitions Guidance

Low Community Restrictions:

- Social distancing of 6 ft.
- Use classroom restrooms and sinks as much as possible
- Use signouts for students leaving the classroom
- Use tape on floor to designate traffic flow
- Limit hallway traffic
- Designate enter/exit doors for high traffic areas
- “Push in” for specials as much as possible to limit transitions

Moderate Community Restrictions:

- Hybrid model for instruction

High Community Restrictions:

- Remote instruction

Suggested Materials:

enter/exit signs, tape for floors, extra soap/paper towels, carts or bins for traveling teachers-
(Wombacher-Music, Schmidt- Music, Walker-Library, Walker- 4 Art, Reinert-Speech,
Skolut-Speech, Special education, Withington-Title, Unger-At Risk, Rodriguez-ESOL)

Common Space Guidance

Low Community Restrictions:

- No whole group gatherings
- Social distancing of 6 ft.
- Frequent hand washing
- Allow students to use hand sanitizer frequently
- Cover water fountains
- Close bathroom stalls to allow for distancing
- No sharing supplies
- Remove supplies or furniture that is not easily cleaned (ie. anything fabric, stuffed animals, extra books, other typically shared supplies)
- Remove extra furniture to allow for more space as possible

Moderate Community Restrictions:

- Reconsider departmentalizing subjects across if used
- Hybrid instruction

High Community Restrictions:

- Remote instruction
